General Meetings – October & December 2018

Santa Claus Parade – given that the parade fell on the same weekend as a KPI production, members felt that a donation would suffice this year.

EODL – KPI's participation in a one-act play while continuing to perform two-act plays twice a year; and, hosting a future EODL One-Act Play Festival will be on the Spring GM agenda.

KPI Kids – Assistance is required from members to assume a mentorship role for the children in upcoming performances. This is to teach children the “ins” and “outs” of theatre. Please contact Mary-Anne Leang or Laura Drover if you are able to assist. This will be on the Spring GM agenda.

Spring Play – “The Day They Kidnapped the Pope” directed by Darrel Nunn – we are still looking for a Producer. If one does not come forward from the membership, the President will send out an email to theatre groups outside of KPI. Performances are in May 2019.

Lafferty's Wake – a great success as we are still receiving accolades from the public. We took in \$20,000 and had a profit of over \$7,000 with 4 of the 6 performances sold out. Some attendees had trouble hearing the performance. The President will be in contact with the Municipal Centre to see if the sound system can be improved.

Executive Meetings:

Wording in Minutes Regarding Decisions: Executive agreed that each decision should include the word “unanimous”; “majority”; or, “rejected” as appropriate.

By-laws revision deferred to the January Executive meeting. In the review, consideration to be given as to whether some of the by-laws should be in the Constitution or remain as by-laws. If there is a policy required, it will be written and put directly on the website. The revised by-laws will be provided to the membership at the Spring GM.

Production Guidelines – excerpts from the descriptions in the guidelines to be provided to volunteers for the positions they will assume.

Committee Chair positions remain vacant: Wardrobe Mistress; and, Publicity – need an enthusiastic person who enjoys writing for this position. Limited number of Executive meetings required.

Costume Hut – Some of the items have appeared and no one seems to know who put them there. We need to know who has access and see if we need to change the locks.

50's Reunion – Reaching out to past members and potential new members for an event to celebrate KPI's 50 years. The majority agreed that KPI should host an event in the new year – further discussion to take place at the Executive meeting in January.

Fall 2019 Play – Looking for a Director and Producer. It was decided that in future rehearsal dates should go out with the audition information so that candidates can decide whether or not they are available.

Murder Mysteries – a performance of “Rock N’Rolly” and a dinner for the following venues: St. John’s United Church – Mar. 23/19; Masonic Hall – April 27/19; and, Equinelle – Sep. 14//19.
